

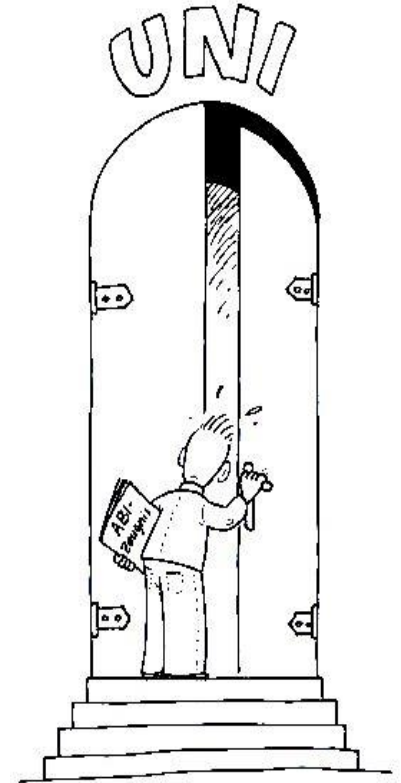

Login details (g number) via Unisono, otherwise: Present your student ID in the user service (ZIMT, Hölderlin, level 2)

- **Email address** („@student.uni-siegen.de“)
 - Access to webmail on <https://mail.uni-siegen.de/>
- **WiFi (eduroam)**
 - User name and password same as email
 - Important: add **@uni-siegen.de** to your user name! (e.g. g123456@uni-siegen.de)
 - Worldwide access at universities and their educational facilities

- Examination periods: 1st examination date: February 6th - March 1st, 2019
2nd examination date: March 18th - March 29th, 2019

Exam regulations

- Describes all policies for a consistent regulation of exams in the respective degree subjects:
 - Basic terms and general regulations for the examination process
 - Degree structure
 - Variations of examinations
 - Composition of the examination board
 - Other important details

Kinds of exams

- **Exam**
 - graded
 - single or module exams
 - can be retaken twice
- **Study achievement**
 - ungraded
 - examiners accredit the predicate “passed”
 - unlimited trials

Possible exam forms

- written exams
- oral exams
- projects/case studies
- seminar works with presentation
- Master thesis

Exam organisation

- Exam dates and rooms are announced on the website of the Examination Office
- Registration for and cancellation of exams is done in Unisono
- Registrations and cancellation can be usually done up to one week prior to the exam
- If you get ill, you need a doctor's certificate and have to submit it to the examination office within 3 days, together with a form (which you can download from the EO website)
- Exam results are published in Unisono and in the EO

Regulations (extract)

- A module is passed if it has been graded with „D“ (4,0) or better, and every ungraded achievement has been awarded the predicate „passed“
- Every failed study achievement can be retaken without restriction
- Every failed module final exam can be retaken twice
- A passed module final exam or Master thesis can not be retaken

Grades (I)

1 = A = an excellent achievement,

2 = B = an achievement significantly exceeding the average expectations,

3 = C = an achievement fulfilling the average expectations,

4 = D = an achievement fulfilling the expectations despite its shortcomings,

5 = F = an achievement not fulfilling the expectations due to significant shortcomings.

For a more nuanced evaluation, the grades can be increased or decreased by values of 0.3; the grades 0.7 and 5.3 are excluded.



Grades (II)

The module grade is as follows:

With an average up to 1.5:	A,
With an average between 1.5 and 2.5:	B,
With an average between 2.5 and 3.5:	C,
With an average between 3.5 and 4.0:	D,
With an average above 4.0:	F.

Modules

- Modules are thematically and temporally rounded, coherent and evaluated, examinable and autonomous qualification units comprehending a topic domain
- A module can include several module elements. The number of credits can be found in the module handbook
- All module elements are offered at least once in a year, sometimes even once in a semester
- Modules are finished by passing the module final exam, accrediting the credit points for the module
